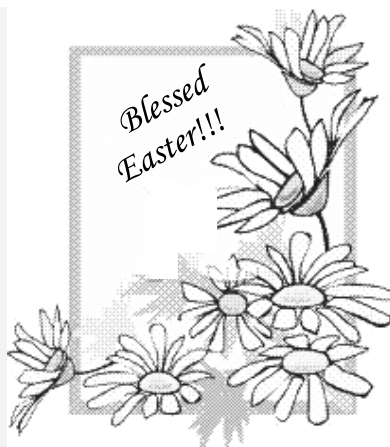

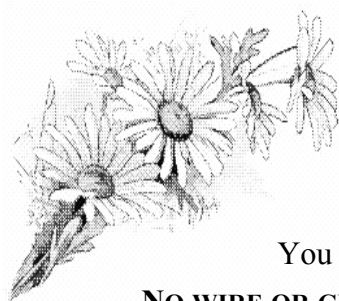

### *Do Not Forget to Seize This Opportunity*

#### **Prices are on the rise...**

The Lutheran Cemetery Association has not had a price increase in over two years. Unfortunately all good things come to an end. Due to the rising cost of maintaining both cemetery properties, vendor costs, equipment repairs, utilities... and the list goes on, we are forced to put a price increase into effect on March 1, 2014. The prices of burial rights (grave space), interments (opening & closing of graves) and memorials will all be affected.

The silver lining to this dark cloud is...*we will honor last year's prices if you call to set an appointment to buy grave spaces, prepay your opening and closing or design a memorial before March 15, 2014. All you have to do is call to set an appointment from now to April 15, 2014.*

*As an additional incentive to consider pre-planning we will continue to accept 10% down and the balance paid in twenty four monthly installments interest free!*
