

Rev. Friedrich Conrad Dietrich Wyneken Day

1st Annual LCA Commemoration for F.C.D. Wyneken will be held On May 2nd at 3:00 P.M. at Lutheran Cemetery in Cleveland, Ohio where Mr. & Mrs. Wyneken's ashes were buried together on April 25th, 1895. Rev. Peeter Pirn of Unity Lutheran Church in Cleveland, Ohio will be the liturgist and Rev. Troy Neujhar of St. Peter's Lutheran Church (18000 Van Aken Blvd. Shaker Heights, Ohio 44122) will be the Preacher. The service will take place at their gravesite in Section G, Lot 42. Born Verden, Hanover, Germany. Missionary in Indiana, Michigan, Ohio, 1838-1845. Pastor of Second German Evangelical Lutheran St. Paul's Congregation of Baltimore, MD, 1845-1850. Pastor, Trinity Lutheran Church, St. Louis, MO, 1850-1865. President, Lutheran Church--Missouri Synod, 1850-1865. Pastor, Trinity Lutheran Church, Cleveland, OH, 1865-1876. Died San Francisco, CA, 1876.
