Decorations must be kept in regulation vases to assure they will remain during lawn mowing season.
We will NOT be responsible for vases left in the upright position during the winter season.*

Regulation Vases

All decorations during lawn mowing season must be confined to a regulation vase, with the exception of a cross flush mounted to the memorial.

Regulation Vases are those that stand securely in a base and are able to be lowered below ground level when not in use.

When the mowers pass decorations not contained in regulation vases, the decoration may be drawn out of the ground and pulled under the deck of the mowers. This can cause potential danger to staff and visitors.

Decoration Restrictions

In order to preserve the cemetery and protect all visitors from possible harm the Lutheran Cemetery Association strictly prohibits the following

- ⊗ The use of Stakes
- ⊗ Digging holes to secure decorations
- ⊗ Any ornamentation made of metal, wire, glass, stone or like materials
- ⊗ Inappropriate cemetery decorations

Potted Plants / In Ground Plantings

POTTED PLANTS are permitted on Easter, Mother's Day, Memorial Day and Father's Day. Plants must be removed within seven days of the holiday. If the plants are not removed in a timely manner the staff will dispose of them at their earliest convenience.

PLANTING on the gravesites is strictly prohibited.

If you are inclined to tend to a flower bed please notify the office and we will arrange for your assistance in a specific area.

Rules and Regulations

Declaration

Long experience proves that if the great majority of people are to enjoy pleasant and harmonious cemetery conditions, certain general practices must be observed. The purpose of such rules and regulations is not to impose unfair restrictions on those people who recognize and regularly practice the commonly accepted standards of citizenship, courtesy and plain common sense. Rather they exist to define and protect the rights of all who visit and to insure the fullest cooperation. The staff appreciates every attempt you make to comply with the enclosed information

Dates to Remember

March 1 — Cemetery Staff begins removal of ALL Winter Decorations

March 10 — Visitors may begin bringing Spring and Summer Decorations

November 5 — Cemetery Staff begins removal of ALL Summer Decorations

November 15 — Visitors may begin bringing Winter Decorations

Do NOT use regulation vases during the winter. Remember to keep vases in their storage position to prevent damage when not in use.


